11th ENTERYNG WORKSHOP (ENTrepreneurship Research workshop for YouNG scholars)

Workshop organized by University of Naples Parthenope, 29-30 May, 2025

The ENTERYNG Workshop “ENTrepreneurship Research workshop for YouNG scholars” (formerly known as AEM-TIM workshop and DREAMT-CYFE workshop) represents an opportunity for PhD students and early-career scholars to discuss their research collecting constructive feedback from a dedicated group of scholars who have been involved with the workshop over the years. Beyond fostering fruitful discussions, the workshop also aims to build an international community of emerging researchers focused on entrepreneurship, innovation, international entrepreneurship and family business, while connecting them with experienced, senior academics. Participants will benefit not only from feedback on their working papers but also professional development keynotes delivered by internationally renowned scholars. These sessions are designed at encouraging deep reflections on personal research and career trajectories while offering practical advice on conducting impactful research. The 11th edition is hosted and organized by the University of Naples Parthenope and University of Naples Federico II. This year the workshop will also feature two dedicated sessions related to two PRIN projects funded by the Italian Ministry of Education:

1. A session with working papers related to the PRIN project INSPIRE - “Digital INnovation EcoSystem DeveloPment for the CIRcular Economy: the startups' perspective”,
2. A session with working papers related to PRIN project IEES – “Institutions, Education and Entrepreneurship Studies: a Novel Perspective on University Impact”.

Target group and eligibility

The workshop represents a valuable opportunity for doctoral students and early-career scholars (e.g., post-docs) to present their work in a friendly environment and to attend professional development activities

Application and selection process

Applicants aiming to present their paper are requested to submit a full paper (which should not exceed 40 pages including tables, figures and references) or an extended abstract (which should not exceed 10 pages including tables, figures and references).

Applicants have to submit a full paper or an extended abstract to enteryngworkshop@gmail.com by the 1st April 2025.

Please use Times Roman 12 font and double-line spacing with 2.5cm or 1 inch margin all around. The papers or extended abstract should clearly present the research topic and objective, the related literature and theoretical background, the methodological approach, the finding and contributions. - Applicants that wish to participate in the workshop without presenting a working paper are requested to email a CV and a statement of their motivation in participating in the workshop.

A maximum number of 25 papers will be accepted.

Selection criteria

Papers will be selected based on the following criteria:

- Relevance of the research objective
- Theoretical and methodological rigor
- Clarity
- Potential contribution to theory and practice

Workshop format

Authors will present their working paper during the parallel sessions. The following timing will be applied:

- For extended abstracts, authors will have 10 minutes to present and 10 minutes to receive feedback from the assigned discussant.
- For full papers, authors will have 20 minutes to present and 20 minutes to receive feedback from the assigned discussant.
- Parallel sessions and keynote speeches will take place on 29th and 30th May.
- Special sessions: IEES - "Institutions, Education and Entrepreneurship Studies: a Novel Perspective on University Impact" and INSPIRE - Digital INnovation EcoSystem DeveloPment for the CIRcular Economy: the startups' perspective; PRIN Projects funded by the Italian Ministry of Education
