GREEN PASS AND RULES FOR ARRIVAL IN ITALY ACCORDING TO THE REGULATIONS OF THE ITALIAN MINISTRY OF HEALTH

The **green pass** is mandatory for conventions and congresses in Italy starting from 6 August 2021: even the aggregative events are in fact included in those activities indicated by the decree law of 23 July 2021 for which access it will be necessary to have the **green certification**.

All participants must be in possession of a green pass, which certifies that they have carried out:

- 1) the complete course of vaccinations
- 2) have received at least one dose of vaccine (in this case, the validity lasts until the date of the second dose)
- 3) to have had a swab with negative results in the previous 72/48 hours or to have been cured of Covid.

All people arriving in Italy by any means of transport must necessarily fill in the passenger location form (Passenger Locator Form - PLF) digitale – dPLF

- Connect to the site: <https://app.euplf.eu/#/>
- follow the guided procedure to access the dPLF
- choose "Italy" as the country of destination
- register on the site by creating a personal account with username and password (you need to do it only the first time)
- confirm the account via the link arrived at the email address indicated (it is necessary to do this only the first time)
- fill in and send the dPLF following the guided procedure

Once the form has been sent, the passenger will receive the dPLF in pdf and QRcode format at the e-mail address indicated during registration, which must be shown directly from his smartphone (in digital format) at the time of boarding, at the hotel and in accreditation phase at the Congress. Alternatively, the passenger can print a copy of the dPLF to show at boarding.

The dPLF must be sent before boarding. However, the field relating to the seat number assigned on the flight will always be editable.

Countries of the European Union and the Schengen area: entry with COVID-19 green certification

The COVID-19 green certification makes it easier to travel to Italy and to other European Union countries and to the Schengen area countries. To enter Italy with the COVID-19 green certification, travelers must be in one of the following conditions, certified by the certification:

- have completed the prescribed anti-SARS-CoV-2 vaccination course for at least 14 days
- or be cured of COVID-19
- or having made a molecular or antigenic swab 48 hours before entering Italy with negative results.

Israel, the United States, Japan and Canada

It is possible to enter Italy with the Certifications issued by the respective countries also by Israel, the United States, Japan and Canada under the same conditions as the European countries (List C). To find out the procedure, consult the dedicated sections: List C (for Israel) and Japan, Canada and the United States.

United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland

For those coming from the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland (including Gibraltar, Isle of Man, Channel Islands and British bases on the island of Cyprus), with the order of 18 June 2021, the quarantine measure was introduced. 5 days with buffer requirement. India, Bangladesh e Sri Lanka

The new ordinance has extended until 30 July 2021, the measures in force for entry into Italy for people coming from or who have stayed in the previous fourteen days in India, Bangladesh and Sri Lanka. Go to the section dedicated to India, Bangladesh and Sri Lanka

Exceptions to the obligations envisaged for those entering Italy

Provided that no COVID-19 symptoms arise, there are specific exemptions to fiduciary and buffer isolation measures.

Exemptions issued by the Ministry of Health

Exclusively aimed at those who enter Italy from the countries listed D and E for exemption from the obligations of fiduciary isolation and health surveillance

A specific request must be made to the Ministry of Health by the subjects entitled to it, or in the event that:

- entry into the national territory occurred for work reasons regulated by special security protocols, approved by the competent health authority
- entry into the national territory occurred for non-deferrable reasons, subject to authorization by the Ministry of Health and with the obligation to present to the carrier at the time of boarding and to anyone appointed to carry out the checks a certificate that prior to entry into the national territory, to a molecular or antigen test, carried out by means of a swab and negative result

Procedure requests for exemptions issued by the Ministry of Health

Office 3 of the General Directorate of Health Prevention (USMAF-SASN Coordination) will examine the request and in the event of a positive response and in line with current legislation, it will transmit the guidelines to which the traveler must comply in order to be exempted from the obligations of fiduciary isolation. .

In order to allow the correct analysis of the request, it is necessary to produce the documentation as per the procedure below, in all its points and also make sure to forward the request at least 7 working days before the date of entry into Italy to the email address:

In case of sending by Certified Electronic Mail - Pec, also indicate an email address on which to receive the reply. Requests sent via Pec may take longer to be handled.

Below the procedure to follow for sending the documentation:

- in the body of the email provide the following information:

o name and surname of the beneficiary of the waiver;

o travel itinerary: in case of arrival by plane / ship indicate the flight number, date of arrival in Italy, place of arrival in Italy;

in the case of arrival by private vehicle / entry by land, indicate: plate of the private vehicle, date and point of access in the national territory.

- fill in each part of the waiver request form making sure that everything is sent in a single pdf document, together with the following documentation:

o travel itinerary (copy of the plane ticket or any other means of transport used)

or valid identity-documents (Passport)

In particular:

- in case of entry for work reasons it is necessary to attach in addition:

o the letter from the company for which the employee works (employment letter), signed by the legal representative of the latter, which certifies and confirms the work needs in Italy to be carried out exclusively in presence.

- in the business letter, provide the following information:

- o name and surname of the beneficiary of the waiver;
- o travel itinerary: in case of arrival by plane / ship indicate the flight number, date of arrival in Italy, place of arrival in Italy; in the case of arrival by private vehicle / entry by land, indicate: plate of the private vehicle, date and point of access in the national territory.
- in the case of entry for non-deferrable reasons, it is necessary to send all the documentation proving the actual non-postponement of the event and a letter signed by the interested party containing the following information:
 - o name and surname of the beneficiary of the waiver;
 - o travel itinerary: in case of arrival by plane / ship indicate the flight number, date of arrival in Italy, place of arrival in Italy; in the case of arrival by private vehicle / entry by land, indicate: plate of the private vehicle, date and point of access in the national territory.

All documentation must be produced exclusively in pdf format and in a single document common to all beneficiaries of the request (documents sent in different formats will make the request invalid)

We also remember:

- that the exception is to be considered valid only for the purposes indicated and only if it complies with the legal requirements in force
- not to submit requests for scheduled arrivals beyond the expected date of effectiveness of the DPCM in force
- Further documentation may be required

In the case of documentation sent in a way that does not comply with the procedure described or does not according to the indicated timing, the request cannot be processed.

The traveler will take care to bring with him:

- communication from the office that sent the protocol;
- the dPLF self-declaration
- the result of the negative test to be shown to the Border Authority or the Health Authority if necessary.

The addresses to which the request should be sent are:

This exemption applies only to travelers who are allowed to enter Italy as per current legislation.

Further exceptions for proven business reasons

Provided that no symptoms of COVID-19 arise and without prejudice to reporting obligations.

the obligation to submit the green certification does not apply:

d) to anyone who enters Italy for a period not exceeding one hundred and twenty hours for proven work, health or absolute urgency needs, with the obligation, at the expiry of said term, to leave the national territory immediately or, failing that, to start the period of surveillance and fiduciary isolation;

e) to anyone who transits, by private vehicle, in the Italian territory for a period not exceeding thirty-six hours, with the obligation, at the expiry of that term, to immediately leave the national territory or, failing that, to start the surveillance period and fiduciary isolation;

g) to the staff of companies and entities having their registered office or secondary office in Italy for travel abroad for proven work needs lasting no more than one hundred and twenty hours;

In any case it is mandatory before accessing the accommodation facilities to have carried out a negative molecular swab certifying the absence of covid infection
